

HOW TO MAKE DAISY CHAINS



DAISIES

Explore your back and front yards or the local park for small, long stalked daisies, grasses or other flowers. Look in fields that will be mowed and make sure to only take as much as you need.



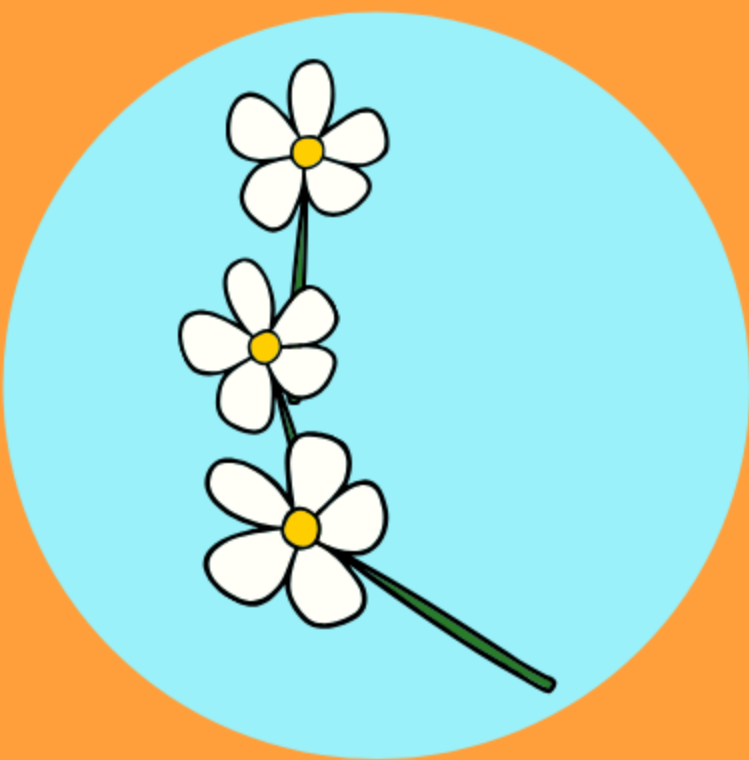
STEP 1

Take one daisy, using your fingernail, run your fingernail a centimetre along the stem to split the daisy stem lengthways.



STEP 2

Using another daisy, thread it's stem through the split stem to link them together.



STEP 3

Repeat step 1 on each daisy stem to then continue with step 2 until you have your desired daisy chain length.



MAKING A LOOP

To make a bracelet, necklace or crown, thread the last daisy stem into the first stem to link them all together.



VARIATIONS

Try variations making flower crowns with different flowers, herbs and plants. You can use string to tie them together. Not just for girls at all!
