What You Need

Natural materials found on the ground.

 Clay, dough, string, wool or any other materials to stick or tie it together

TIP:

▼ Instructions

- 1. Look for some natural materials in your backyard or local park, such as gum nuts, seed pods, acorns, feather and leaves. Take care not disturb any (tiny) animals or damage nature in the process
- 2. To make your bush bilby, you could use a gum nut, clay or dough or something else to make the body. Then try and find something round for the tail and some leaves or feathers for the ears.
- 3. Then stick it all together! You could use clay or dough to stick parts into or string, wool or any other materials to tie the parts together.



Extension Activities

- Try and make some other bush creatures out of natural materials.
- Name your bush bilby or creature(s)
- Write a story about your bush creature. In what kind of habitat would they live? What would they eat? What sound do they make? What is their magic power?
