Instructions

Extension Activities

- Make a big picture in which you paint all your fungi together.
- Pick a fungi or two that you were interested in and research about it
- Make a story about the real or imagined creatures that would use these fungi to live in, sit on,

1. Look under trees, in the grass and on tree trunks. Make sure not to touch the fungi!
2. Share what types of fungi you are spotting
3. Take or draw a picture of each fungi you find. Later at home you can look up what type of fungi it is.
4. Are the fungi together in groups or standing alone? Are there animals around them? What are they doing?
4. See how many different types you can find.
